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## Welcome to the Good News Club!

Over the past 76 years, God has given *Child Evangelism Fellowship (CEF)* a number of unique ministries which have proven to be effective tools in our effort to evangelize and disciple children with the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ. In an average year, over 12 million children are reached worldwide in 185 countries. CEF is a Bible-centered organization composed of born-again believers who advocate for children to live in the Word of God and become part of a local church for Christian living.

CEF has many different ministries for children, but the three primary ones are the *Good News Club*, the *5-Day Club* and the *Truth Chasers Club*. For teens, another exciting program available through CEF is *Christian Youth in Action (CYIA)*.

CEF provides classes to train their workers and other Christians who are burdened for evangelizing children. In fact, training Christians to effectively minister to children has been core to the ministry since it was founded in 1937. Training is offered throughout the USA and around the world through seminars, conferences, and



formal courses.

CEF Press produces and distributes Bible and missionary lessons and related materials for use in teaching children to help accomplish the goals of the ministry. Teaching materials are available to the public. Many products are translated into some 189 different languages and distributed around the world. *Good News Club* is a ministry of CEF in which trained teachers meet with groups of children in schools, homes, community centers, churches, apartment complexes, just about anywhere the children can easily and safely meet with their parent's permission. Each week the teacher presents an exciting Bible lesson using colorful materials from CEF Press. This

action packed time also includes songs, Scripture memory verses, a missionary story and review games or other activities focused on the lesson's theme. Each Club includes a clear presentation of the Gospel and an opportunity for children to trust Jesus as Savior.

Currently, the *Good News Clubs* are serving at 21 schools in the Inland Valley which include the cities of Menifee, Murrieta, Lake Elsinore, and Temecula.

Mat Staver, president of Liberty Counsel, says, "The most positive thing to happen to public schools is Good News Clubs. Many youngsters will never attend a church unless the church comes to them. These clubs provide an unprecedented opportunity to restore the culture, one young person at a time."

# New Curriculum for 2014/15



A local Good News Club

After extensive research, CEF has concluded that most children who begin attending a Good News Club have no biblical knowledge of their Creator. Children are living in cultures of chaos where anti-God philosophies and dangerous concepts of the spiritual world bombard children's minds and souls. The new material is still solidly based in the Old and New Testaments of the Bible but the "meatiness" of the curriculum will be enriched to

intentionally teach a greater scope of God's attributes and connect all lessons to the overall redemption story.

Each subject covered in the new four year curriculum will have five lessons with an additional sixth lesson for review. Each lesson will still have a character building Bible lesson, interactive songs, integral Bible verses to memorize, a mission story and Wonder Time, which will focus on a child's personal

relationship with God.

The themes for this year will include: God: *The Creator King*; Jesus Is God Who Cares for People; God's Plan in Action: *The Early Church*; and The Patriarchs: *God's Plan Unfolds*. In addition the children will also have a Christmas lesson, Valentine's Day lesson, a Resurrection Celebration and a Watermelon Party! At the end of the year we will also have the popular and always fun, Go For the Gold!
